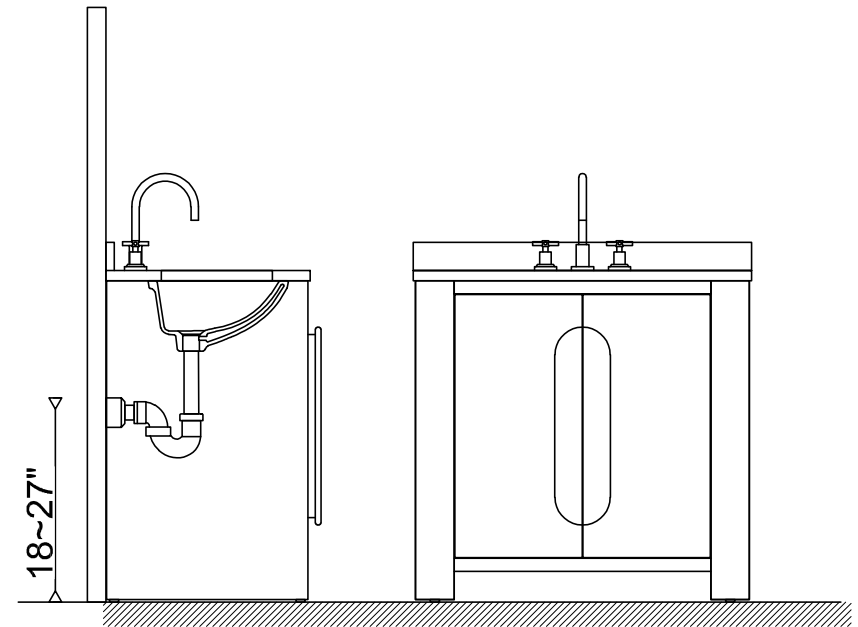

Before beginning to assemble and install your vanity, please check that you have received all of the parts and hardware listed in the Packing List. Please report any missing items to your local vendor immediately.

To avoid scratches, scuffs, and other damage, do not assemble your vanity directly on the floor. Place a sheet of cardboard or another protective surface on the floor, and assemble your vanity on top of it. Always protect all surfaces from sharp objects, high heat sources, direct prolonged sunlight, and harsh chemicals.

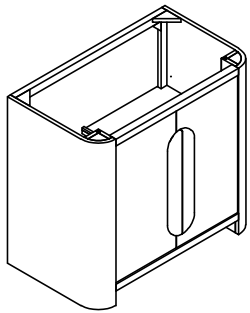

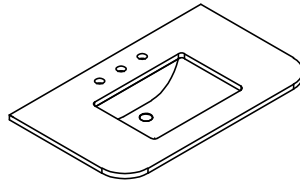

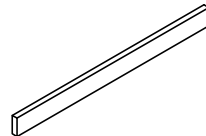
A-Main Cabinet x1



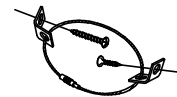
B-Vanity top with sink x1

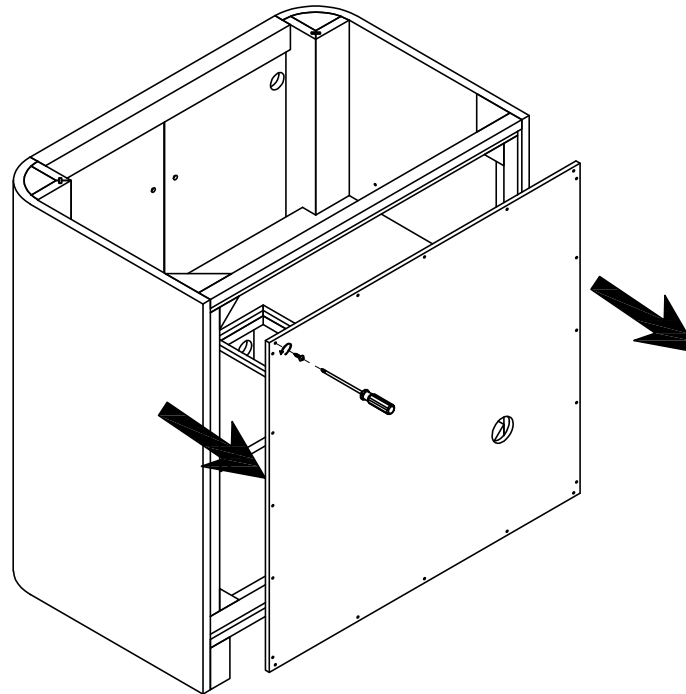

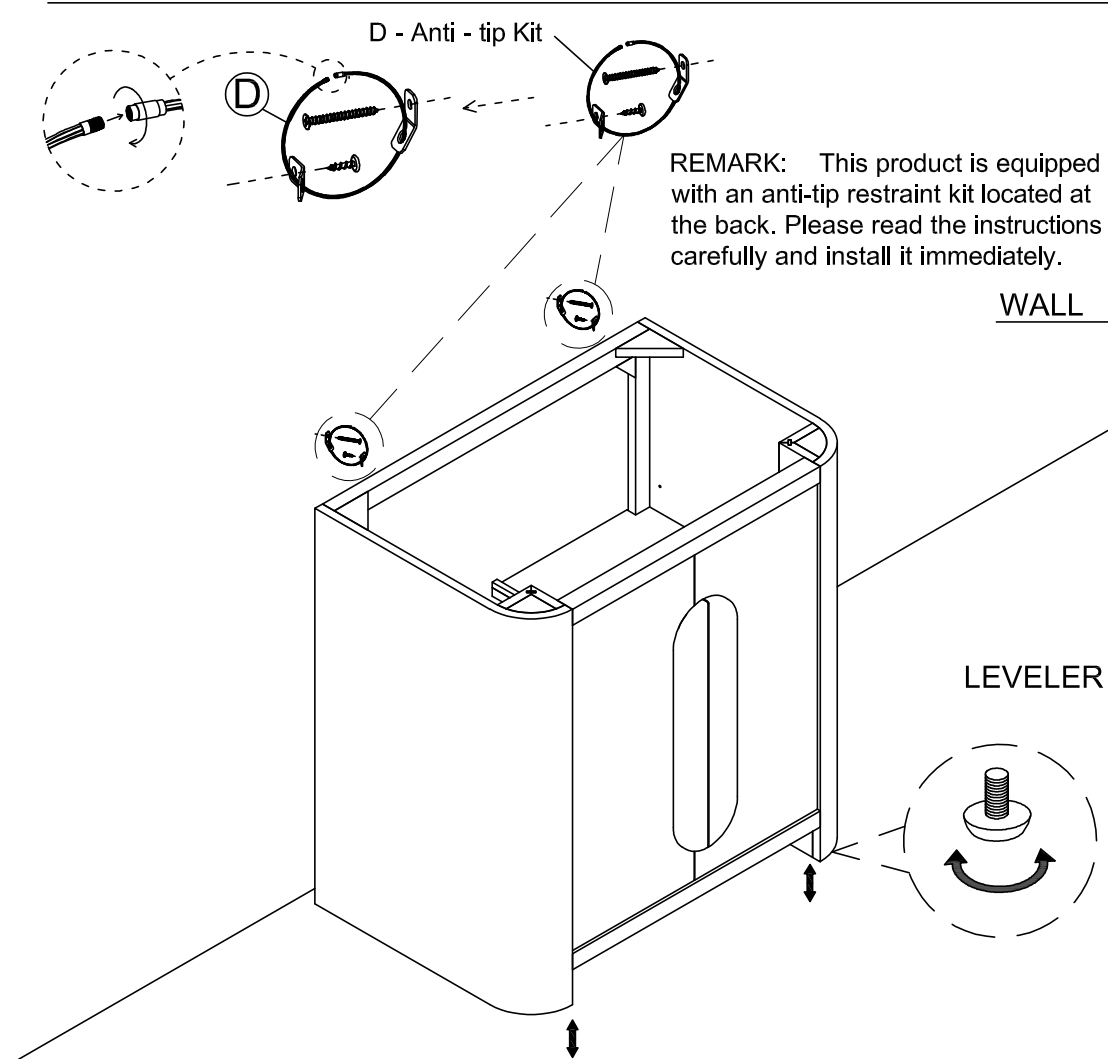


STEP1

STEP2



Adjusting Floor Levelers :

Your furniture has been professionally crafted and pre-adjusted. However, minor shifts may occur during transportation. If the drawers are misaligned or the furniture feels unstable, adjusting the floor levelers will help restore proper alignment and stability.

How to Adjust the Floor Levelers:

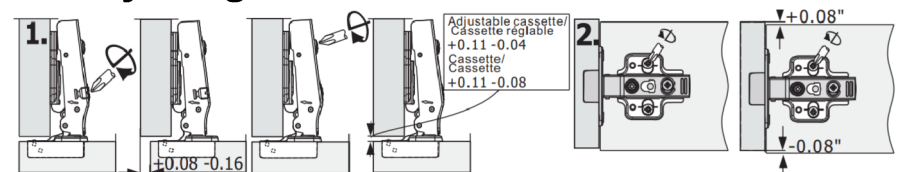
Check Stability – Place the furniture in its final position on a level surface. If it wobbles or does not sit evenly, adjustment is required.

Locate the Levelers – The adjustable levelers are located at the bottom corners of the furniture.

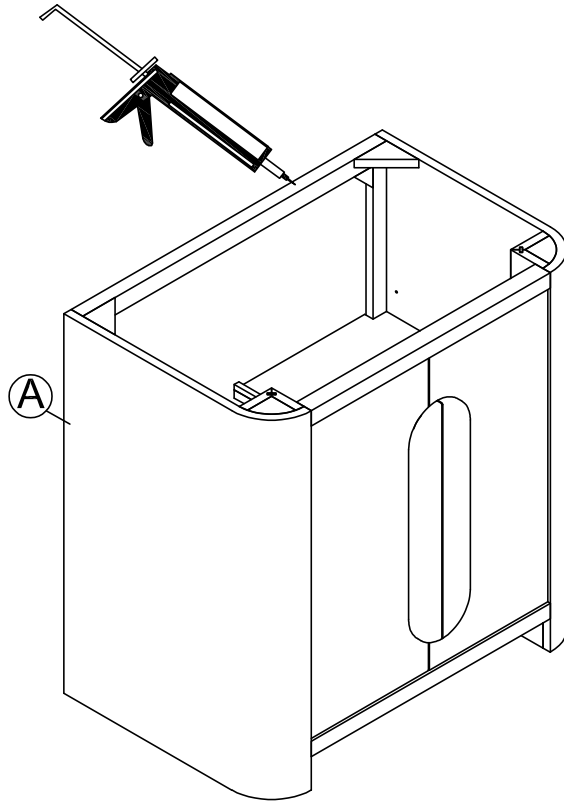
Adjust as Needed – Turn the levelers clockwise to raise the furniture or counterclockwise to lower it. Make small adjustments and check stability after each turn.

Repeat if Necessary – Continue adjusting in small increments until the furniture is stable and level.

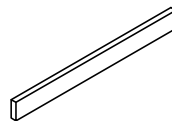
A-Main Cabinet x1



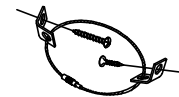

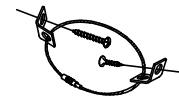
B-Vanity top with sink x1
